



- Introduced on 1st January 2014 with new Rules of Government Works
- "Formal purposes": standarization, transparency
- Material purposes: stimulate
 - qualitative analysis
 - quantitative analysis

- Evaluation







In case of complex projects (with many issues) IA only for the most important changes




