REFIT initiatives in preparation – examples:

- ✓ Information and consultation of workers
- ✓ Veterinary Medicines
- ✓ Company law
- ✓ Integration of Business Statistics

New Initiatives 2014:

- ✓ New comprehensive architecture for business statistics
- ✓ Extension of the VAT one-stop-shop to all business to consumer supplies and Development of an EU VAT web information portal
- ✓ Simplification of EU legislation on identity and travel documents





REFIT proposals pending in legislative procedure:

- ✓ Animal health
- ✓ Consumer product safety and market surveillance
- ✓ The Common Consolidated Corporate Tax base
- ✓ Package travel, holidays and tours
- ✓ Introduction of a standard VAT declaration



REFIT proposals adopted – implementation

- ✓ New legal framework for public procurement
- ✓ Recognition of Professional qualifications
- ✓ Recording equipment in road transport (tachograph)
- ✓ Clinical trials with pharmaceuticals



Repeals- examples:



New Repeals 2014:

- ✓ Energy labelling of some households devices
- ✓ Transport rates and conditions
- ✓ Standardized reporting in the area of environment
- ✓ Agriculture obsolete acts in relation to CAP



Withdrawals – examples:



New withdrawals 2014:

- ✓ Investor compensation schemes
- ✓ Aviation security charges
- ✓ Pregnant workers
- ✓ Fund for compensation of oil pollution damage in European waters
- ✓ Hygiene of foodstuffs



EU added value under assessment:



- ✓ Occupational safety and health for hairdressers
- ✓ Muscular skeletal disorders and screen displays
- ✓ Environmental tobacco smoke



REFIT Evaluations:

- ✓ Health and safety at work
- ✓ Food law
- ✓ Chemicals (not covered by REACH)
- √ Visa Information System
- **✓** Frontex
- ✓ NATURA 2000

New evaluations 2014:

- ✓ Mutual Recognition of goods
- ✓ Consumer protection on timeshares
- ✓ Late payments
- ✓ Construction sector
- ✓ Design system in the EU
